"Ed Says"

"Air Cooled"

One of the features of the Corvair is the fact that it is Air Cooled. There is certain areas that have to be maintained to keep it that way. The body to motor seal MUST be in place all the way around on both early and late models. The heater outlets and hoses also must be in good condition. The thermostats for the heat outlet must be in proper operating condition. And of coarse we know the fan belt should be checked for proper tension and in good condition. The oil cooler shield should be removed and check the top of the oil cooler for debris and then replaced. When rebuilding your engine make sure you check all head passages for flashing and debris that can block cooling passages. Early finned oil coolers and 12 plate coolers can be installed to improve cooling. All these tips can insure proper cooling of your Corvair engine. Any one of these cooling tips missing can cause an engine to overheat as some members found out on a recent trip to Hinkley in the 100 degree heat. Ed Lampi

"Ed Says"

"Air Cooled"

One of the features of the Corvair is the fact that it is Air Cooled. There is certain areas that have to be maintained to keep it that way. The body to motor seal MUST be in place all the way around on both early and late models. The heater outlets and hoses also must be in good condition. The thermostats for the heat outlet must be in proper operating condition. And of coarse we know the fan belt should be checked for proper tension and in good condition. The oil cooler shield should be removed and check the top of the oil cooler for debris and then replaced. When rebuilding your engine make sure you check all head passages for flashing and debris that can block cooling passages. Early finned oil coolers and 12 plate coolers can be installed to improve cooling. All these tips can insure proper cooling of your Corvair engine. Any one of these cooling tips missing can cause an engine to overheat as some members found out on a recent trip to Hinkley in the 100 degree heat. Ed Lampi







"Ed Says"

"Air Cooled"

One of the features of the Corvair is the fact that it is Air Cooled. There is certain areas that have to be maintained to keep it that way. The body to motor seal MUST be in place all the way around on both early and late models. The heater outlets and hoses also must be in good condition. The thermostats for the heat outlet must be in proper operating condition. And of coarse we know the fan belt should be checked for proper tension and in good condition. The oil cooler shield should be removed and check the top of the oil cooler for debris and then replaced. When rebuilding your engine make sure you check all head passages for flashing and debris that can block cooling passages. Early finned oil coolers and 12 plate coolers can be installed to improve cooling. All these tips can insure proper cooling of your Corvair engine. Any one of these cooling tips missing can cause an engine to overheat as some members found out on a recent trip to Hinkley in the 100 degree heat. Ed Lampi
