Ed's Corvair History



In 1960, as the "Big Three" Auto manufacturers were bringing out their compact cars, the idea of Chevrolet's Corvair engineering took my interest. The thought of an air cooled, trans-axle design was so different from what had been the normal way of automobile manufacture for years. As I read up on the features of the Corvair, I became more interested. In early 1961, I had left the employment atone of the large retail department stores and later went to work as a salesman at the local Chevrolet dealer. As the newest salesperson I was given the use of a 1961 Monza 4-Door Sedan with a 3 speed Transmission. It was definitely a fun car to drive. While I left their employment after about 3 months, I had developed a feeling that I would be a Corvair owner. Some time later, an auto Dealer going out of business, had a 1960 Corvair 700, 4-door, Automatic Transmission for sale at a very reasonable price. It would be ideal for my wife to learn to drive, so it was purchased. She did learn to drive and received he drivers license. While I have never been employed as a mechanic, I've done my own auto repairs. I also learned to work on the Corvair as it needed repair and Maintenance. In 1969 when the Corvair Automobile was discontinued. It immediately became a throw away car. Corvairs could be bought and sold cheap. I revived quite a few of their neglected Corvairs through out the years.

I retired in 1983 and, having A 1963 Corvair parts car in the yard, I was looking for a restorable 1963. I finally found a 1963 Spyder body that I felt was worth salvaging. It took it a while to get it all together. The first time it appeared at a car show was in Hoyt Lakes in 1988. Since then I have had been to most of the car shows in northern Minnesota and Wisconsin. And most times the only Corvair, winning over 75 trophy's. It was sold in 1999 and a 1968 Corvair Monza Sports Coupe has taken it's place. Corvairs are showing up more and more and I feel I've led the way throughout the years.

"Fuel Pumps"

New Corvair Fuel Pumps have been suffering from reliability problems. It seems that most of the suppliers of new fuel pump replacements are having problems from getting a reliable source of diaphragm material. Most new cars today are using electric fuel pumps, so sources for a good material for diaphragms somehow seems to be lacking. A lot of the Corvair parts suppliers still tell us that they have licked this problem. I've had some very poor luck with a couple of Corvair parts sources in which a total of 4 fuel pumps have been defective. Two that failed the first time they were used and a couple that would run until they heated up then they would quit. Unfortunately, this all happened within a 5 month period, and to have that many failures makes one wonder if it's possible to find a good reliable source. I finally had to put in an electric unit which seems to be working fine, so far. It seemed that the 40 yr old pumps that still operate are the most reliable. While my experience was probably remote happening, you should be aware that it can create a problem.
